

Subject	Detail
Communication and Language	This term, we shall be working on the children's understanding of narrative and explanation writing. They will be focussing on key features of a narrative and retelling a well known story, before creating their own based on what they have learned. Following
	this, the children will be working on their explanation writing- looking at facts and securing sentence structure. YR children will continue to develop their understanding of how to write words, captions and sentences with increasing independence. Throughout all of our writing opportunities, the children will continue to develop their understanding of full stops and capital letters.
Mathematics	The children will be covering Place Value, skip counting and sharing, time and fractions. Please see the <u>additional sheet</u> for more information.
Science	The children will be focusing on humans, linking to their PSHE work, and plants. Please see the <u>additional sheet</u> for more information.
Understanding the World	The children will be looking at how water can be used, and compare Cambridge to a water side city in Zambia. Please see the <u>additional sheet</u> for more information.
Computing	This term, the children will work on logging on, accessing their secure Google account, and using the chromebooks to support their learning. Alongside this, we will be using the BeeBots to explore different continents, and the ipad to record our work.
Art and Design	During the first half term, we shall be cooking in D&T. The children will be investigating a city in Zambia and shall use a range of skills to create a Zambian salad. Please see the <u>additional sheet</u> for more information.

PE	The children will be developing their skills with completing a range of athletics activities, as well as beginning to learn about striking and fielding games (such as cricket) The second half of the term, the children will be developing their water confidence and swimming in our onsite swimming pool.

As well as this, we will be exploring a range of differing communities to promote and demonstrate our British Values of respect and tolerance.
