Please check age restrictions and the content your children are being exposed to. We can help support.


Curriculum









Focus on vocabulary

Assessment

Ongoing assessment within lessons in a range of different ways throughout the term.

At the end of each term, children complete NFeR assessments to give a standardised score in:

- Grammar and Punctuation
- Spelling
- Maths (Arithmetic and Reasoning)
- Reading Comprehension

Year 3/4 and Y5/6 statutory spelling words are also assessed each term.

Alongside this, children's writing is assessed and recorded through pieces of work, and their reading fluency is also assessed.

Positive start for every session

Celebrating good choices / warnings and modelling of how to 'make a change' if a wrong choice is made

Parental / carer support is vital

Reflection time option - please discuss sheet with your child and return

Home learning and support

Attendance and punctuality

Google account - including Google Classroom

Reading daily (or as often as possible)

Times tables - little and often

Spelling - Y3/4 and Y5/6 words

Homework - set weekly on Friday, for following Wednesday

Class toys / diaries - Paddington, Olive and Flame

Special Person card - complete by Monday each week

Websites to support learning -Spelling Frame, Times Tables Rockstars, Maths Frame
