## Swimming Pool Pupil Swim Membership Information



The Great Abington Primary swimming pool will be open in 2025 to:

- Current school pupils (primary school age children only)
- Pupils who have a confirmed offer of a place for September 2025
- Children of our volunteer pool carers

**The price for a pupil swimming pass for the season is £50 - note:** the price is the same irrespective of the number of children in your family eligible to use the pass

School holiday - (from August 23rd to August 31st)	Swimming pool access
10:30 - 12:30 (Mondays to Friday)	Pupil pass holders

Term Time - Weekend (from September 6th to September 14th)	Swimming pool access
10:00 - 12:30 and 2:00 – 5:30 (Saturday and Sunday)	Pupil pass holders

- Please note that the pool is not open outside these times for safety reasons as the water needs regular chemical treatments.
- In order to use the pool your family must be a valid pass holder.
- Please do not upload (social media) photographs or videos of other people's children.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Note: adults are not allowed in the pool.
- Childminders may accompany nominated children, provided the child has a valid pass, during the season with written permission from the parents / guardians.
- Please ensure that equipment is used responsibly and report any damage, breakages or lost items to the pool carers via the WhatsApp group
- Pool users must acquaint themselves with the Pool Rules and Requirements supplied to all pass holders (copy held at school office and poolside). These rules must be observed at all times. Failure to do this will compromise the safety of all children.
- A WhatsApp group will be created so that all pass holders (adults) and pool carers can communicate efficiently to support care of the pool and to manage numbers at each session.
- The maximum number of children in the pool is 20.
