Dear Headteacher,

We hope that you and your colleagues are well.

The last few years have been a challenging time for all of us and this year we are hoping to ensure that our prospective Year 7 students receive a more straightforward in person primary transition rather than having to provide a virtual alternative.

To this end, we are outlining below our plans for the next few months. Although we hope we can go ahead with these plans, they are of course subject to change, and we will keep you updated on any advice we receive.

Transition Data Collection

We would like to thank those who have completed and returned the online transition data forms, we would really appreciate the remaining forms asap as we are using this information to sort students into their form groups, and we will write to parents confirming their child's form group later in June.

Transition Visits

In June, our Year 7 team and some of our current Year 7 students will visit primary schools to talk with students about their transition to secondary school. This will also give us the opportunity to meet with the Year 6 teacher to discuss prospective students. As always, talking to you about your students gives us huge insight and really helps us prepare for their arrival at secondary school.

For our feeder primary schools, we will be arranging for members of our Science, English and Language teachers to provide a short lesson at your school. For our smaller primary schools, we will be inviting students into SWCHS for a Bridging Day in July to receive the same lesson content and to provide interaction with other students from smaller school settings.

All About Me Booklets

We have attached the All About Me booklet to this email and would be grateful if you could ask each prospective SWCHS student to complete this. They will need to bring it with them on our Taster Day in July. We are writing to prospective parents and students by email this week to update them on our transition plans and will inform them of the booklet should you wish to set it as homework.
