We are a partnership school with Homerton, Cambridge University and really value the opportunity to work alongside trainees who are passionate about entering the profession and making a difference to the lives of young people. As a small school you will quickly be immersed in all facets of school life and if you like a challenge then we would be a great school for you to consider.

Outdoor learning is an area of particular strength with many opportunities for you to develop your practice. We have access to Abington Woods and River Granta stream across the academic year (apart from January and February) and also have an extensive provision within our own site. We have a level 3 Forest School leader who will lead sessions alongside you in Abington Woods. We are a Level 5 RHS schools award holder, a Platinum Sports Games school and the lead school in the Nationwide Harmony project. We strive to give staff and pupils the best opportunities for enrichment. This year we have worked closely with the Parish Council on re-developing the multi use games arena which we have access to throughout the year. In the summer term we will be launching pickleball as a school.

Early Career Teacher time is valued and provided by Laura Lungley our SENCO and Pupil Premium leader which supports your class consistency and calmness. The experienced staff team will also be a great support with a range of expertise areas.

Class 4 is a large classroom that has a 4k touch screen with digital presenter and additional whiteboard spaces that can be utilised to support your class.

Alongside being the Class 4 teacher you are a family group teacher meaning that you will get to know a fifth of the school very well through events across the year. These include a Children in Need ramble, reading sessions and sports activities.
